1. Representatives of the faculty students' council are elected

2. Active and passive voting rights

The right to vote and stand as a candidate can only be exercised by eligible voters who are entered in the electoral register. All eligible voters can only vote and be elected in one faculty students' council. Members of the student body who belong to more than one student council must indicate in which faculty students' council they exercise their right to vote by the time the electoral register is closed. If this declaration is not made, eligibility to vote is determined by the faculty students' council that is assigned first in the electoral register. All members of the constituted student body are entitled to vote, regardless of their nationality. Guest students do not have the right to vote. All voters have three votes in each ballot.

3. Electoral register

The complete electoral register will be available for inspection in the StuRa from Fri 07 November 2025 to Tue 18 November 2025 during the opening hours of the Service Office. A written request for a change can be submitted to the returning officer against non-registration or incorrect registration until the closing of the electoral register on Tuesday, 18 November 2024 at 4 p.m..

4. Nominations

Nominations must be made in writing and are only permissible as individual nominations. The relevant form must be used at stura.tu-dresden.de/elections. It must be clear from the election proposals that they relate to the election of the faculty students' councils. It must also be clear which faculty students' council they relate to.

Election proposals must be submitted by **Tue, 18 November 2025 at 4 p.m.** to the returning officer.

A nomination must include the surname, first name, programme, semester, date of birth, gender and email address of the applicant. By signature on the nomination form, the applicant declares their consent to stand for election. The relevant form can be downloaded from the StuRa website.

The submission deadline ends on 18 November 2025 at 16:00. Nominations submitted after this time cannot be considered.

The approved election proposals will be announced on the Internet at stura.tu-dresden.de/wahlen and posted on a notice board by **Fri 28 November 2025** at the latest. There will be no separate information about the admission of the nominations.

5. Election date

The elections will take place from Tue, 09.12.2024 to Thu, 11.12.2025.

Details on times and polling locations can be found in the joint annex "Wahlräume zu den Universitäts- und Studierendenschaftswahlen 2025" to this election notice.

6. Voting by mail

Voting is also permitted in the form of postal voting. Applications for the election documents to be sent to the election officer must be submitted by Wed, 20 November 2024 at the latest. If the voting documents are collected in person, the application must be submitted by Thu, 04 Dec. 2025 at the latest. Section 12 of the election regulations provides further details. The application for postal voting documents can only be made online and can be found at stura.link/briefwahl. The ballot envelopes must be received by the electoral officer by 4 p.m. on Thursday, 12 December 2024 at the latest. Election documents can be handed in at the StuRa service office during opening hours.

7. Determination and announcement of the election results

The public counting of votes will take place immediately after the end of voting in the respective counting rooms. The list of counting rooms will be published at stura.tu-dresden.de/wahlen. The election results will be submitted to the election committee by the chairpersons of the voting committees. The election committee will then determine the provisional election results and publish. The official result will be posted in the StuRa and published on the dedicated website after the election documents have been checked and after a decision has been made on any election challenges received.
